

My place in the World

You will need:

- Paper and pencil
- 8 different sized circular objects to draw around
- Colouring pencils/felt tips/paints.
- Wool, string, thread or a split pin.
- Scissors

There are over 7.8 BILLION people in the World but each one of us is very special. We are all unique. Think about where you feel you belong....


Did you think about your home? Your street? Your town or city? Bet you didn't think about which planet you belong to. So let's think about your special place.

- Draw around your 8 objects and carefully cut out your circles.
- Order them from largest to smallest
- Each circle represents a different place and for each circle you are going to think about yourself and your place there.
- In each circle you will draw (stick pictures work well) or write about you in that place.

1. In the smallest circle draw you and name it '**ME**' as they have in the picture.
2. The next circle is '**YOUR HOME**'. Draw a picture of your home.
3. '**MY TOWN or CITY**' Draw a picture of the town or city you feel you belong to.
4. '**MY AREA or COUNTY**' Draw a picture of the area/county you feel you belong to.
5. '**MY COUNTRY**' Write about the Country you feel you belong to.
6. '**MY CONTINENT**' Which Continent do you feel you belong to. Write or draw.
7. '**MY PLANET**' Draw or write about how you feel about Earth, as that's where we all belong.
8. '**MY PLACE IN SPACE**' Think about space and how you make up a tiny but important part of it. Draw a picture or write some words about how you feel.

Finally, using the string/wool or split pin, join the circles together, as you can see in the picture, and remember to name each circle.

Ask for help if you need it.



Talk to your family about what you've created and ask them to think about their place in the World.
